Outstanding Full-Time Lecturer Teaching Award

Purpose: To recognize, encourage and stimulate high quality teaching for lecturers within the New York Section of the American Chemical Society.

The nomination for this award includes:

- 1. Candidate's CV including list of courses, curriculum development, and outreach activities.
- 2. Up to three letters of support from superiors, associates, or local section members' evaluating the nominee's achievements as a teacher.
- 3. Up to four testimonials from former students.

These documents should demonstrate the candidate's

- a. Quality of teaching and maintenance of current subject knowledge
- b. Department/college service including course development work
- c. Ability to challenge and inspire students
- d. Awards

The nominations are due November 15, 2025. This is not a self-nominating award. And it is open to any Lecturer teaching in the current year who has held an appointment for at least 5 semesters prior to the current semester and have taught at least 20 credits at the college /university.

The candidates need not be a member of the American Chemical Society. The Award Committee of the New York Section will review the candidates and select the awardee. Unsuccessful candidate's files will be kept active for a period of three years. Any updating of a candidate's nomination packet will be welcomed. The award consists of a plaque and a one-year ACS membership (regular ACS member dues and New York Local Section dues included). The awardee will be formally recognized at the NY ACS Section-wide Conference held in January 2026.
