Outstanding Adjunct (Part-Time) Teaching Award

Purpose: To recognize, encourage and stimulate high quality teaching for part-time instructors within the New York Section of the American Chemical Society.

The nomination for this award includes:

- 1. Candidate's CV including list of courses, and outreach activities.
- 2. Up to three letters of support from superiors, associates, or local section members' evaluating the nominee's achievements as a part-time teacher.
- 3. Up to four testimonials from former students.

These documents should demonstrate the candidate's

- a. Quality of teaching and maintenance of current subject knowledge
- b. Ability to challenge and inspire students

The nominations are due November 15, 2025. This is not a self-nominating award. It is only for an adjunct faculty in the current academic year who has held an appointment for at least 8 semesters or four years (sequentially or non-sequentially) prior to the current semester and have taught at least 20 credits at the college/university. The candidates need not be a member of the American Chemical Society. The Award Committee of the New York Section will review the candidates and select the awardee. Unsuccessful candidate's files will be kept active for a period of three years. Any updating of a candidate's nomination packet will be welcomed. The award consists of a plaque and a one-year ACS membership (regular ACS member dues and New York Local Section dues included). The awardee will be formally recognized at the NY ACS Section-wide Conference held in January.
